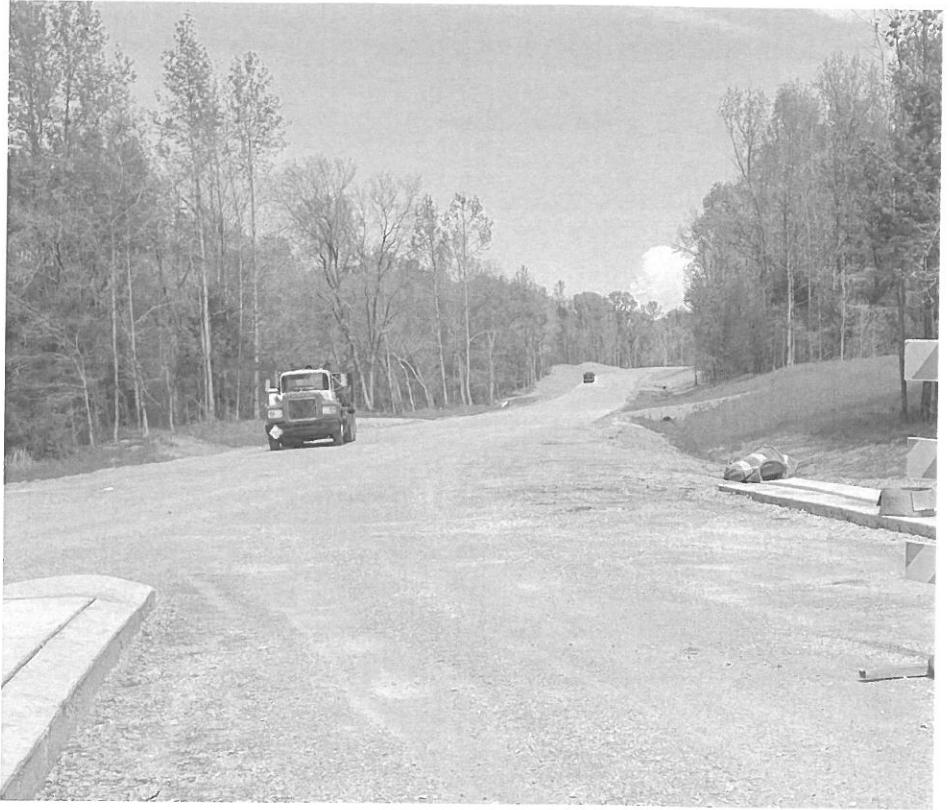

The second phase of the West Oxford Loop extension will open to traffic at 7 a.m. on Tuesday, according to Lafayette County officials.

While construction is still underway, the road will be open to the public to improve access to the Industrial Park and alleviate traffic congestion in the area. Officials urge drivers to use caution, as the final stage of work has not yet been completed.

Still left to complete is the widening of Industrial Park Drive, adding a roundabout, and applying the final asphalt surface.

The West Oxford Loop project is a joint effort between Oxford, Lafayette County, and the Mississippi Department of Transportation. The first phase connected West Oxford Loop to College Hill and was later named the George G. "Pat" Patterson Parkway.

The final phase of the long-term project will complete a connection between Highway 6 West and Highway 7 North, a goal that has been part of city and county transportation plans for more than two decades.
